

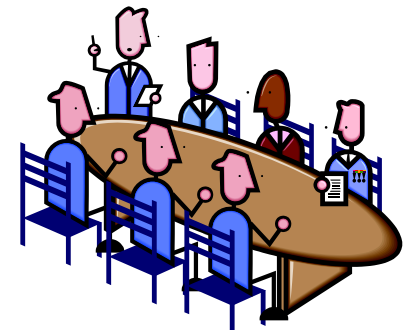

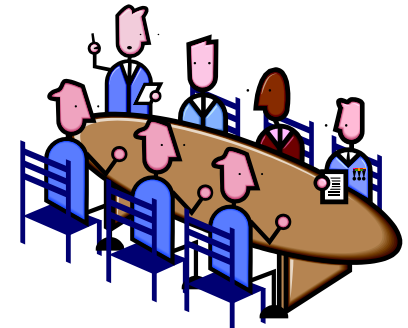


Committees Updates
